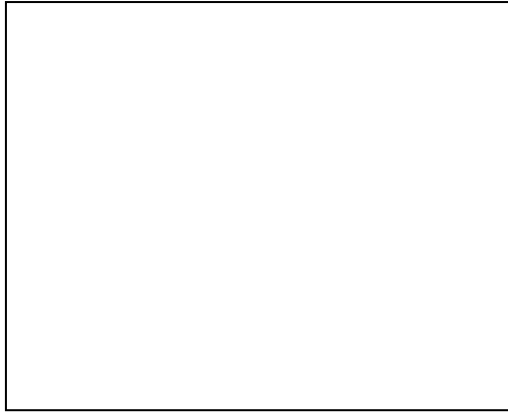
Find in the exhibition the genius head depicted here!
