

# AMFI FESZT

WHEN THE ARENA COMES BACK TO LIFE

## REGULATIONS

**Event:** AmfiFeszt • **Date:** 8–10 September 2023 • **Organiser:** Friends of Aquincum • **Location:** 1036 Budapest, Pacsirtamező Street 2-14.

Within the area surrounded by Viador – Szőlő – Nagyszombat – Pacsirtamező Streets: at the Military Town Amphitheatre (monument), its north-western, north-eastern and south-western foreground covered with grass, its southern foreground, Viador Street road surface, Szőlő Street pavement and road surface until Zápor Street as well as the courtyard of the Árpád Secondary Grammar School and Óbuda University opening from Szőlő Street, as well as the Katinyi Mártírok Park (hereinafter the Event Site).

1. It is dangerous and forbidden to climb up/down, stand on, or jump from the Roman wall remains, the sewers or any protruding, high (including modern) feature at the Event Site! It is dangerous and forbidden to enter closed-off areas!
2. It is dangerous and forbidden to stand on or go within 50 cm or less of the edge of the Roman building remains at the Event Site designated for the movement and presence of those in attendance!
3. Any theft, vandalism or other offence or crime committed on the Event Site will result in criminal prosecution and immediate expulsion from the event.
4. Approach with caution areas and activities that pose a risk to physical safety (e.g. re-enactment or craft demonstrations) and keep a safe distance!
5. For the safety of our cultural heritage and all those present at the Event Site, please follow the directions of Event Contributors and the instructions of Organisers. Security Staff have a right and duty to notify, warn and take action against those in breach of the Regulations.
6. Everyone takes part in the Event and the individual programmes at their own risk. The Organisers do everything they can to ensure the Event is run safely, but accept no responsibility for any personal injury, property damage or other damages – especially those caused by irresponsible conduct or not observing the rules. Please pay special attention to the safety of persons younger than 18 years of age in your care or group.
7. The Military Town Amphitheatre and the courtyard of the Árpád Secondary Grammar School and Óbuda University may be accessed only via the designated gates. Entering (or leaving) via a non-designated point is dangerous and strictly forbidden! The Event Site may be accessed only via the designated points. Entering (or leaving) via a non-designated point is dangerous and strictly forbidden!
8. It is strictly forbidden to enter the Event Site with a motor vehicle without a permit! It is strictly forbidden to ride into the Event Site on a bicycle or scooter!
9. Visitors receive at the gates of the Military Town Amphitheatre a day entry stamp free of charge which they must wear during the Event and must show to the Organisers' agents upon request for inspection. The day entry stamp is valid for multiple entries on the given day.
10. Please place your trash in one of the many bins provided. Please use the (temporary) toilet facilities for their intended purpose. The use of non-designated places as a toilet is strictly forbidden!
11. Smoking at the Event Site is only permitted at the designated smoking area(s).
12. The Event may be visited with disability assistance dogs (of all sizes) and small and medium-sized dogs (of a height of less than 40-55 cm at the withers and/or of a weight of less than 12-34 kg). A visitor may enter the Event Site with a maximum of 3 dogs. A dog may only be brought in on a leash or in a carrier. Under no circumstances may a dog designated as dangerous be brought in. Visitors must keep their dog by their feet on a short leash. Only those visitors may bring a dog to the Event Site who have the full ability and capability necessary for controlling, handling and restraining their dog. Only healthy, well-socialised, clean, house-trained dogs with a suitable temperament may be brought to the Event Site and in such a way that they do not endanger the health and safety of others, arouse fear or disturb the peace of visitors. Only those dogs may be brought to the Event Site that were dewormed within no more than 3 months, given the vaccines appropriate for their age and fitted with a microchip. Upon request, the visitor with a dog must present evidence thereof. Visitors with a dog are responsible for all acts of their dog, for all damages caused by their dog and the consequences (violation of the criminal code, civil code and regulations and particularly for paying all compensations and damages). The cleaning up of dog excrement and the disposal thereof at the designated place is the responsibility of the visitor with a dog.
13. It is forbidden to enter the Event Site in clothing incompatible with the cultural heritage setting, as well as to engage in conduct and activities that are flagrant, incompatible with the historical monument setting, or in breach of general social norms. In all cases, proceedings will be taken against those who commit an offence and/or crime.
14. For security purposes cameras are in operation on public domain and in the courtyard of the Árpád Secondary Grammar School and Óbuda University in accordance with the law. Visual and audio recordings are taken by the Organisers of the Event for documentation and publicity purposes and any person may be included in the recordings. The persons appearing in the visual and audio recordings may not make any claim against the Organisers, the producers of the recordings or their rightful users.
